



We Got the Job: Intercounty Connector Contract D/E

We are pleased to announce that the Maryland State Highway Administration has awarded ICC Constructors (IC3) the \$89 million design-build contract for the final phases of the Intercounty Connector project in Maryland. IC3 is a joint venture of Shirley Contracting, Clark Civil, Dewberry and Davis, Facchina Construction Company, and Trumbull Corporation.

Led by Shirley Contracting, the joint venture team will construct 0.9 miles of four-lane, tolled roadway with a partial interchange and crossing bridge at Virginia Manor Road and a continuous flow interchange at U.S. 1. The scope of work also includes 0.7 miles of improvements to U.S. 1, 2.4 miles of resurfacing on I-95, and construction of 2.4 miles of collector-distributor roads adjacent to the north- and south-bound lanes of I-95.

Intercounty Connector Contract D/E will complete the 18.8 mile highway that connects I-270/I-370 in Montgomery County to I-95/U.S. 1 in Prince George's County. IC3 completed Contract C of the highway in November of last year.

Construction began in February and completion is scheduled for January 2014.
