## Water Treatment Plant Site Access and Program Administration Facilities

We are pleased to announce that Loudoun Water has awarded Shirley Contracting a \$7.4 million design-build contract for the Water Treatment Plant Site Access and Program Administration Facilities project. This contract is the first phase of Loudoun Water's proposed water treatment plant.

The project will take place in three stages. During the first phase, Shirley will install bridge reinforcements and make road improvements to allow construction vehicles to access the proposed water treatment plant site. Stage one also will include the construction of temporary administration facilities, including the project management offices and contractor staging area.

During stage two of construction, Shirley will widen the existing Gant Lane and provide an underground utility conduit system for permanent power, internet, and telephone service at the water treatment plant.

The final stage of the project includes the design and construction of a 1,600 linear-foot permanent access road with a new 250 linear-foot bridge over Sycolin Creek, leading to the water treatment plant site.

Design is currently underway and the project will be completed in April 2015.
