## Route 7 Westbound Truck Climbing Lane

We are pleased to announce that the Virginia Department of Transportation has awarded Shirley Contracting a \$28 million design-build contract for the Route 7 Westbound Truck Climbing Lane project in Loudoun County.

Under this contract, Shirley will construct a westbound truck climbing lane for heavy vehicles traveling on Route 7. The 2.6-mile climbing lane will be built between the interchanges of West Market Street and Route 9 to improve traffic operations and the safety of motorists traveling the westbound lanes. The project team will construct new roundabouts and perform ramp improvements to the interchanges of Route 7 and Route 9. They also will relocate the Washington and Old Dominion Trail and make modifications to adjacent secondary roads, including the construction of a local subdivision street.

Additional project components include right-of-way acquisition, stormwater management, utility relocation, quality assurance, quality control, and community relations on the project.

Design of the project is underway with completion scheduled for October 2015.
