Pacific Boulevard Extension Project

We are pleased to announce that the Virginia Department of Transportation has awarded Shirley a \$28 million change order to complete the Pacific Boulevard Extension Project in Loudoun County, VA. As part of our ongoing efforts on the Route 28 Corridor Improvements PPTA Project, the design-build contract will extend four lanes of Pacific Boulevard north from Nokes Boulevard to Russell Branch Parkway, including a 500-foot-long bridge over Broad Run. The project team also will widen an existing section of Pacific Boulevard from two lanes to four on the south side of Nokes Boulevard. In addition to the design and construction, Shirley will perform right-of-way acquisition and utility relocation.

Financing for the project is being provided by a Virginia Transportation Infrastructure Bank (VTIB) loan from the Virginia Resources Authority to a private developer - KINCORA. This innovative financing approach leverages future opportunities to complete critical transportation improvements prior to the start of development. This is the first VTIB loan to be awarded to a private entity. Shirley assisted throughout the multi-year loan approval process by drafting the application, coordinating with VDOT, and providing pre-construction services including design, scheduling, and pricing.

Design efforts are underway and completion is scheduled for the summer of 2016.
