Route 28 Hot Spot Widening

We are pleased to announce that the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has awarded Shirley a \$45 million design-build change order to the Route 28 Corridor Improvements Project to widen a section of Route 28 adjacent to Dulles International Airport in Loudoun and Fairfax counties.

The change order is part of a Public-Private Transportation Act contract that will complete 10 grade-separated interchanges and widen Route 28 from six to eight lanes between Interstate 66 and Route 7.

The project team will expand almost nine miles of Route 28 throughout three heavily congested hot-spot sections. The team will begin construction on the southbound lanes from Sterling Boulevard to Route 50 and move northbound, widening lanes from McLearen Road to the Dulles Toll Road.

Shirley's scope of work will include the design and construction of an additional lane in each section, turning Route 28 into a four-lane highway. The team also will connect Route 28 to overpasses on the Dulles Toll Road, which are currently being constructed by Shirley. The project also includes widening the Route 28 bridge over Horsepen Run.

Design is underway and construction will begin in the Fall 2015. Substantial completion is scheduled for May 2017.
