



RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY FOR RIVERSIDE PARKWAY

Lorton, VA - May 16, 2019 - Shirley Contracting Company, LLC (“Shirley”) joined representatives of Loudoun County and One Loudoun Holdings, LLC for a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of Riverside Parkway. The project was a \$3.7 million change order to the \$25 million Route 7/Ashburn Village Boulevard Interchange project in Ashburn, VA.

Speakers at the event included James Zeller from the Virginia Department of Transportation, Loudoun County Board of Supervisors Suzanne Volpe (Algonkian), Ralph Buona (Vice Chair Ashburn) and Phyllis Randall (Chair-at-Large), and Bill May from One Loudoun.

Shirley constructed a four lane, median divided roadway with a shared-use path on the north side of the road. In addition, a new traffic signal was installed at the intersection of Ashburn Village Boulevard and Riverside Parkway. The completion of this short segment of road provides connection to Lexington Drive on the north side of Route 7. The light at Lexington Drive and Route 7 will be removed before year end relieving a critical choke point on Route 7. Lexington Drive will eventually be renamed Riverside Parkway.
