



RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY FOR ROUTE 606 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OVER I-95 WITH 606 IMPROVEMENTS

Lorton, VA - June 26, 2019 - Shirley Contracting Company, LLC (Shirley) joined representatives of Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), Spotsylvania County, and Virginia House of Delegates for a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of Route 606 Bridge Replacement over I-95 with 606 Improvements Project. This \$16.5M design-build project replaced the structurally deficient Route 606 Bridge over I-95 and reconstructed portions of Exit 118 at I-95.

Speakers at the event included Virginia House of Delegates Representative for the 54th District, Robert D. Orrock, Berkeley District Supervisor Kevin Marshall and VDOT Fredericksburg District Engineer, Marcie Parker, P.E.

Designed by Dewberry Engineers Inc., the project team created an innovative and proprietary design concept that improved traffic flow at Exit 118, while minimizing the amount right-of-way needs and traffic impacts during construction. The project scope included improvements to the interstate ramps, Route 606 (Mudd Tavern Road) east of I-95 and Mallard Road. The new Route 606 Bridge over I-95 was a significant upgrade to the existing 2-lane structure that it replaced. The new bridge is 4-lanes and includes turn lanes. The interchange is now able to address current and future traffic demand in the Thornburg area. Shirley started construction in October 2017 and completed three months ahead of schedule.
